4	<p>We are currently preparing our prequalification submission for KEBS/PRE-Q/T006/2025/2028 and seek clarification regarding the required documentation for Specialized Subcontractors.</p>	<p>Please note that Clause 25.2 of the tender document does not allow for subcontractors, it states in paragraph</p>

<p>As per Clause 25.2 of the tender document, the Procuring Entity allows applicants to engage Specialized Subcontractors for certain portions of the contract. In our case, we will be working with a Specialized Subcontractor who is our official Representative and Physical presence (and part of our Global organisation chart), in the country X.</p> <p>To ensure compliance, we would appreciate confirmation on whether the following documents are sufficient for our Specialized Subcontractor's portion of work:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lease agreement (confirming physical presence in country X). • Business license (valid for operation in country X). • ISO/IEC 17020:2012 certification (for inspection services). <p>Alternatively, would the specialised subcontractor also be required to provide all documents listed in Section III, such as full financial statements, litigation history, and ownership details?</p> <p>We also like to know if the "Form ELI-1.2 - Applicant's JV Information Form" should be used since the explanatory note below the form's title, suggest that the document should be used for JV as well as Specialized Subcontractor ?</p> <p>We appreciate your guidance on this matter to ensure our submission meets all requirements.</p>	<p>3 that <i>"The Procuring Entity, in ITA 25.2, may permit the Applicant to propose subcontractors for certain specialized parts of the contract as indicated there in as ("Specialized Subcontractors")</i>.</p> <p>For this tender, subcontracting is as guided in Addendum no.1 Question 6.</p>
<p>5 Form CON 2 - Historical Contract Non-Performance, and Pending Litigation and Litigation History refers to "sub-factors" 2.1, 2.3, 2.4 which we could not find in the pre-qualification document. Also, a period of time for the declaration of non-performance is not specified. Could you please confirm how the form shall be completed?</p>	<p>Standard tender Form CON 2 should be filled as is. The period of time of non-performance of a contract should be in line with the contract duration being referred to.</p>
